A. School/Student Safety

- Displayed walking routes and maps posted on school website. Council discussed potential safety concerns and suggested new flashing signs and potential short in one sign north of 12600. Reminder that some children are showing up too early w/o the safety of crossing guards, no one should be at school before 8:10 am. Concern over speeding in parking lots

and drop off/pick up zones. Issues with people parking in teacher/principal designated parking. Reminder to urge parents to send children to school dressed for winter weather, some coats available in office if needed.

B. Trust Land Funds Update (G. York) 20 min

- Based on number of students, can't carry over more than 10%. R. Shreve and K Enniss report no new donors despite efforts to get sponsors. Trust funds usage: art displays are really fun and allow for growth and planning time for teachers. The STEM and STEAM displays have garnered lots of support and attention (robotics art, circuit displays). PTO donated art supplies used by students. Thank you to Allyson for mirror display. Walk to Read instructional aides are majority of Trust funding and huge dividends are being observed in the growth of students who were behind grade level and now at grade level or above.
