4. Review 2026-2027's LAND Trust Plan Implementation and Upcoming Amendments

- A. Goal: Acadiance on or above increase 4% from BOY to EOY, 70% making typical or better growth

- B. How: Additional support in phonics and fluency provided by teachers and literary assistants, literacy enrichment groups, Intervention assistants hired, rotation aides hired, instructional coach, supplement FTEs or hire aides for large classes
- C. If additional money: If unable to hire or retain WTR aides we can increase the hired aide's number of hours to 25, Non-consumable/non-subscription based supplemental reading programs, Chromebooks
- D. The instructional coach is now fully paid for by the district. Roughly \$45,600 will be freed up.
- E. Possible ideas: rotation aide pay increase, pay for more of our intervention aides from this budget, ipads for teachers for progress monitoring (ours are expiring at the end of the year), chromebook replacement, other ideas?
