## **School Supplies**

• Is it possible to get school supplies list ahead of time? This is not allowed to be a requirement. We need to make it abundantly clear that it is voluntary! Mr. York will be able to get class supplies lists.

#### KINDERGARTEN

• Our school was selected as 1/5 schools to be a full-day kindergarten pilot program (outside of title 1 schools).

- We have identified the families that are interested. We will be able to skip the testing portion. All students with IEP will be put in automatically. The rest of the students selected will be by lottery.
- Class of 25 to begin with. This will probably go down because families may discover this is not for them to be in full day.
- There will be 3 kindergarten classes. 1 full day class with one teacher and another teacher will do two ½ days. Teachers have not been determined yet.
- There are modifications that need to happen.
  - Badge scanner added to the kindergarten door
  - Hopefully a gate will be installed to make it easier to get to the cafeteria
  - Rooms may switch depending on who teaches full-day. Inside kindergarten class would be the inside classroom. ½ day would be the outside classroom because they go and leave.

## Drum Bus

- October 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>. One class at a time. Around \$1000-\$1200
- Make sure the drum bus emails get forwarded to Amy Kalbes.
- This has not been paid yet. But we have a sizeable portion from last year that should be used.

## Budget

- We have between \$7000-8000 carrying over last year. Plus the rainy day fully-funded and JAT funded.
