A. Safe Routes Discussion

a. School Concerns

- Still want cameras as previously discussed - **Update the existing camerings**
- Lines on sidewalk and faded or fading signs need to be replaced/fixed.
- PA System needs another speaker on the front south side and one on the front north side - **They have already installed a speaker in the front**

b. City Concerns

- Getting extra Police surveillance around school and in the sky bridge area.
- Riverton High School parking lot crossing
- Drainage at the south crosswalk - **Not a big winter so we aren't sure how well it works.**
- Foliage covering signs have been cleared
- Putting up a permanent speed sign in front of the school to help remind drivers.

B. LAND Trust Update

- a. We should be carrying over 10 percent of the budget.

b. MOY Data

- At the BOY we were at 76%, we improved to 78% for the middle of the year. The EOY goal is at 80%.
- We have had praise from secondary educators about reading skills.

c. Potential Plan for 2026-2027 (\$111,000)

- \$201/student projected
- BTSALP \$32,500 flat rate
- Push forward with Walk to Read - Literacy is important and this is the best option
- \$5000 from PTO will help fill in the gaps as needed for technology for the students.
- 100% of funds go to salaries for teachers, Walk to Read aides, etc.
- Came up with different ideas that could potentially work for next year rotations.
- "Focus on Literacy. Focus on People"
