- iv. The stage got used for a 1<sup>st</sup> grade DLI performance.
- v. The LAND Trust funds are mainly used for hiring assistants and other professionals to support student learning and for technology for our students.
- vi. Beginning of Year Acadience reading data showed 75.9% of Southland students reading at or above grade level. We are currently 4<sup>th</sup> in the district.
